Loch Raven UMC Trip to Europe Sept. 22 to Oct. 3, 2020

Tentative Plans:

Depart BWI on British Airways for Munich, Germany. Spend 4 nights in Munich, take city tour, tour Dachau Concentration Camp, go to Oberammergau for the Passion Play, Hofbrauhous for dinner and entertainment, hop on hop off bus.

Optional trips like Oktoberfest and Neuschwanstein Castle.

Depart Munich on bus for Salzburg, Austria, one of my favorite small towns. Spend 3 nights in Salzburg, famous for the movie *The Sound of Music*, take city tour, hop on hop off bus, go to Hohensalzburg Fortress – Castle on Mt. Festungsberg for a great view of the city and the valley on the other side, a great old town section for walking and shopping. Mozart's house is there also. We have optional tours to Eagle's Nest in Berchtesgaden, Hitler's retreat and Hallstatt an early town on a lake in the Alps.

Depart Salzburg on a bus for Prague with several sightseeing stops on the way. Spend 3 nights in Prague, another of my favorite small towns, tour of the city, go through the Castle on the Hill, cross the famous Charles Bridge built in the 1400's, visit the six hundred year old Astro Clock in the town square, have a Bohemian dinner, visit a market, a fantastic church though not Methodist.

What's included: 10 nights in 3- or 4-star hotels, round trip air on British Airways, tours in every city, breakfast, several meals with entertainment, several special tours. The price is \$3750 per person, based on double occupancy. Payable in 3 installments. One now, one in February and one in July 2020.
