Saturday, November 30 is the return of the Loch Raven Festival of the Arts. Please plan on launching your holiday season at this celebration of the arts. This is a free event. Donations of canned goods will be accepted during this event in support of the Assistance Center of Towson Churches, a local mission supported by our church. The schedule of the festival's activities includes craft activities for children and exhibits by artists of all ages and skill levels. Musical presentations will be held throughout the Festival and currently include the Baltimore Flute Choir at 3pm. Loch Raven church member Erin Mellott will be performing with this group as they ring the halls of the church with the beautiful flute tones of melodies for a second festival year. Joyous Voices, a Dickens-era ensemble that has been holiday singing throughout the mid-Atlantic region since the 1990's, will also be returning.

Many arts and manger festivals have become an annual 10 to 50+ years tradition for churches, providing their communities with celebrations of the arts. We wouldn't want to go around crying about everything. We wouldn't want to go around laughing at everything either. It's been my observation that people don't laugh often enough though.

We are not to laugh the serious situations of life off, but too much intensity kills the spirit and, probably, the body too. I've even found it possible and appropriate to bring laughter into some funerals. If the deceased had a sense of humor, then it makes sense to celebrate his/her life with some laughter.

In this month of Thanksgiving, I am thankful for the sense of humor and laughter that God has given me. Laughter is something that has helped me through many difficult times. I once told a pastor friend of mine who was going through a difficult time to not lose his sense of humor. It's something that has worked for me. It can work for you too.

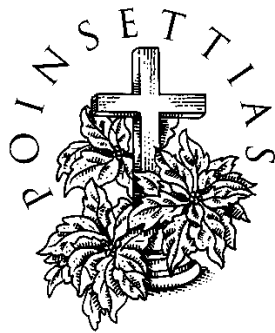
